

**Entering WJEC Short Course (Cash-in 4339 SC, QN C00/0481/5)
and Full Course (Cash-in 4330 SA, QN C00/0477/3)
GCSE Information and Communication Technology (ICT)**

As outlined in the WJEC GCSE ICT specification, candidates may take Unit 1 and Unit 2:

- and cash-in for the short course qualification
- before Unit 3 and Unit 4 and cash-in for a full GCSE qualification at the end of the course
- in the same series as Unit 3 and Unit 4 and cash-in for a full GCSE qualification.

Where candidates have cashed-in Unit 1 and Unit 2 for the short course award, the outcomes from Unit 1 and Unit 2 cannot contribute to a full course award.

It is important to note that if a candidate has cashed-in for a short course qualification in the same series, – **in order to satisfy terminal requirements**, WJEC will process the **short course cash-in first**. This may therefore have a detrimental effect upon the overall full course grade.

Please note that centres will **not be permitted** to remove any cash-in **once results have been issued**
