

Completing WJEC and WJEC Eduqas Answer books - Information for Candidates

WJEC and WJEC Eduqas examinations are completed by writing responses to questions within one of two booklets:

1. An answer booklet where responses to questions are written within a separate answer book.
2. A question-answer booklet where sections for writing responses to each question are provided within the question paper

1. Answer book

2. Question-answer booklet

Information for candidates completing either booklet:

- x Use black ink or black ball point pen only.
- x Complete the information required in the front cover in BLOCK CAPITALS in the space provided. Provide your names in which your entry has been made (do not use nicknames or 'known as' names).

- x Cross through any work that you do not want to be marked.
- x Ensure that your writing is legible. You will not be penalised for poor handwriting, however an examiner cannot mark what they cannot read.
- x DoNOT use pencil, gel pen, pens of any other colour than black or correction fluid
- x DoNOT Tear out any part of the booklet.

Information for candidates when completing a question answer booklet

- x All responses must be written within the space provided.
- x If you run out of space, there may be some additional space at the end of the booklet.
